Date and venue

Copenhagen Gay & Lesbian Film Festival will take place in Copenhagen from October 16th to October 25th 2009 at the Cinematek of the Danish Film Institute, Gothersgade 55, Copenhagen.

Additional screenings can occur at other venues in Copenhagen and in Denmark as well as in Malmö, Sweden.

The Competition

Copenhagen Gay & Lesbian Film Festival is a competitive festival offering a grand jury award to the best feature films in the competition program, as well as jury awards for best shorts and best documentary films, and an audience awards for best film. The awards are cash prizes, given directly to the directors of the winning films.

Film formats

Films can be screened in both 35mm and 16mm format as well as in Beta Pal and other formats.

All entries (DVD and completed entry form) must be sent before 1st of July 2009 to the address above.

Shipping instructions

Films accepted for the festival must be shipped to Copenhagen to the address given by Copenhagen Gay & Lesbian Film Festival. Carrier or shipping company may be recommended by Copenhagen Gay & Lesbian Film Festival.

The general deadline for print arrivals is October 9th 2009. Beyond this deadline the film's participation in the festival cannot be guaranteed.

The entrant should send a note in advance advising Copenhagen Gay & Lesbian Film Festival management of the dispatch of the print to Copenhagen, indicating courier and tracking number.

Unless otherwise agreed, each sender pays the cost of transport of the films to Copenhagen, while the costs for returning or forwarding the print will be covered by Copenhagen Gay & Lesbian Film Festival. Unless otherwise agreed, all prints will be returned to the address indicated by the sender within two weeks of the last day of the festival. Uninvited submissions must be sent prepaid.

The festival does not accept collect shipments without a prior written agreement. The festival does not assume responsibility for, nor will accept, shipments incurring expenses for terminal charges, duties, taxes, or customs brakeage. Clearly indicate on all waybills that transportation and customs charges be billed to the sender. Please remember to clearly indicate that the content is for cultural purposes only.

Insurance

For the period in which the films are in the care of the festival, they are fully insured at the print value given in the entry form. This period lasts from the registration of arrival of the films in Copenhagen until their handing over to a forwarding agent.

Selection

A special committee nominated by the festival management selects the films for the festival program. The festival management may invite films for the competition or for the various programs. The Copenhagen Gay & Lesbian Film Festival programming committee will decide which films will participate in the festival from those submitted.

Decisions of the programming committee are final. For the pre-selection, European-standard DVD discs should be sent (with English subtitles if available) at the senders cost. All successful submissions will be informed September 1st 2009 at the latest.

The entry for participation in any section of the festival implies the unconditional acceptance of all the clauses of the regulations of participation. In cases of dispute

of interpretation of the regulations of participation, the management of the festival has the right to decide on all cases not covered by regulations, as well as allowing exceptions.

The application for participation in the Copenhagen Gay & Lesbian Film Festival 2009 implies acceptance of these regulations.
